To ensure your place in a class, attend the rst class meeting on time. Instructors may drop absent students to make room for students wishing to add the class. If you decide not to continue in a class for which you have enrolled, it is your responsibility to drop the class of cially by using SURF or by submitting a drop card to the Community Learning Center.



Classes may be canceled due to insuf cient enrollment. Every attempt will be made to contact students by email or telephone before the class meets. Students do not need to drop a canceled class.



Parking permits are required when parking at the Community Learning Center (CLC), Oceanside, and San Elijo campuses Monday–Saturday. All vehicles not displaying a valid permit will be ticketed starting February 1, 2016. Students may not park in staff spaces.







### ADULT HIGH SCHOOL

The MiraCosta College Adult High School is designed for students 18 years of age or older who wish to complete the requirements for a high school diploma or prepare to take the GED. Those under 18 who can bene t from instruction are also allowed to enroll. Any student enrolled in a day high school (regular or continuation) must meet the following criteria in order to take classes in MiraCosta's Adult High School: he/she must be a creditde cient student, 17 years old or older, who has attended at least ve semesters of high school. Day high school students must also present a Concurrent Enrollment Permit signed by their day high school principal, counselor, and parent. The forms are available at high school counseling of ces, the Community Learning Center (CLC), MiraCosta's Admissions Of ces, and online at 1 1 , s/,

In order to place students in courses that best meet their needs, individual skills will be

assessed. English, reading, and math courses are also appropriate for persons who do not need a high school diploma but wish to increase their skills in preparation for college classes, for employment or advancement in the workplace, or for personal growth.

MiraCosta College will offer adult high school classes in the San Dieguito Union High School District (SDUHSD) in spring 2016.




