### Additional Fees:

- x Student Health Insurance \$442 (3 months) \$147 per month Students can buy MiraCosta's insurance or buy their own insurance if you choose to use your own plan must meet our minimum requirements and be submitted for approval before the start of the session. Students must sign a waiver and fill out all forms prior to the first day of class. Otherwise, students will be automatically enrolled in our insurance plan at \$380 per 8-week session on the first day. Insurance is required. Contact the director for forms and requirements.
- x Monthly Bus Pass \$58 (optional)- Can be purchased at Cashiers Office
- x Parking Pass \$35 per semester (optional) if driving own car to school. Purchase at Cashier's Office
- x Friday Activities: \$0-\$15 per week English in Action Course (kayaking, bowling, rock climbing, movies, etc.)

The English Language Institute offers international students the opportunity to increase their English language proficiency and develop the skills needed for success in a college or university in the United States. The program is designed for students with a minimum of one year English language training at high school or college level. This class may not be appropriate for advanced ESL students or students with a TOEFL score greater than 500 paper based or 46 IBT. Students must be at least 18 years old or meet our minor policy requirements.

All sessions include the following classes

Vocabulary Reading, Listening, Pronunciation, Grammar, Writing, Speaking, Culture, and TOEFL Preparation

Classes are held 5 days a week for 4 hours each day. International students with an F visa are required to attend all class meetings and every session while in the United States. Students can study for multiple sessions. International students receive admission for a minimum of two 8 week sessions. B1 visitors can attend 16 hour per week of our non-TOEFL classes.
