

Sample methods of evaluation demonstrate appropriate methods of monitoring and assessing student mastery of the skills and abilities identified in the course objectives. The types or examples listed in this section should demonstrate what is appropriate for the content and objectives of the course. The actual assessment methodologies used by any instructor are to be consistent with but not limited by the provided types and examples.

The types or examples listed should accomplish the following:

- x Address, either directly or indirectly, how sample assignments and class activities are evaluated.
 - x Avoid structural and cultural obstacles that may prevent courses from achieving equitable educational outcomes for all student demographic groups.

Providing variable types of assessment, regularly monitoring student performance, and communicating unconditional positive regard are equity-minded methods of engaging students proactively and demonstrating an authentic investment in their success.

Example from LIT 122 Introduction to African American Literature:

Performance objective Analyze literary devices, such as style, setting, and characterization, and explain how these devices contribute to the themes of selected African American literary works.
