

In September 2003, the Board of Trustees approved the designation of trustee emeritus.

To recognize extraordinary and significant contributions to MiraCosta Community College District by a member of the Board of Trustees, trustee emeritus status may be granted by unanimous vote of the board.

The Board of Trustees may confer the designation of trustee emeritus to a board member who has:

- A. Served the college for a minimum of at least eight consecutive years.
- B. Served in a leadership role on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
- C. Contributed significantly to the development of the college.
- D. Provided meritorious service in representing the college to its community.
- E. Demonstrated a continuous commitment to strengthening educational opportunities for local citizens.

The designation of trustee emeritus will be announced in the form

The award will be conferred within one year of the board member

Emeritus trustees may be granted appropriate privileges parallel to full-time faculty and classified staff.
