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3) Dual enrollment courses are a beneficial and equity-minded way for high school students to earn college credit, as there are no enrollment fees. Students who may not have considered completing college level courses now have the opportunity to dip their feet into a college-going culture. Contrast this with AP courses, which do require high school students to pay for and take a test, and college credit is not given for AP courses. Additionally, College and Career Access Pathway (CCAP) AB 288, which creates a seamless pathway to college, allows students to take a higher number of
