Approximately 13,663 students at MiraCosta College may be eligible to participate.

The total number of students that received a grant from Oct-Dec of 2021 is 917.

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

MiraCosta College based the spring 2020 distribution on the number of Title IV eligible students. The amount of \$500 was chosen based on data indicating that the amount is significant enough to provide meaningful assistance while allowing for the maximum number of recipients. Subsequently

choose to collect additional information from institutions in accordance with the reporting requirement in Section 18004(e) of the CARES Act and the Certification and Agreement.
