Phi Theta Kappa Alpha Chi Lambda Chapter Constitution May 7, 2023

Preamble

The purpose of the Alpha Chi Lambda Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) shall be the development of leadership and service, the promotion development of leadership and service, the promotion development of fellowship among the qualified students at MiraCostaCollege. This shall be carried out by the PTK elected officers and upheld by its members.

Article I: Membership

Membershipin the Alpha Chi Lambda Chaptershall consist of Standard Member, Alumni Member, and Transfer Member.

Section1: StandardMember

The decision making authority of the Alpha Chi Lambda Chaptershall be in the Standard Members. Each candidate for membership must have completed 12 semester hour of associate degree coursework with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.5. Grades for courses completed at other institutions will be considered when determining membership eligibility. When a member's cumulative GPA falls below 3.25, he/she has onesem sterto raisehis/heraverage GPA up to 3.25. If the memberfails to do so,

excepttheright to voteor to hold office. An Alumni Member must meet eligibilityequirements as stated in Article IV Section 1C ofRhe Members, with all the rights and privil eges. There are no GPA requirement stachedo this membership category.

Article II: Officers

The officers shall consist open (10) or moreelected Standard Members: President, Executive Vice President/Vice President Service, Vice President Scholarship, Vice President of Public Relations, Vice President of Record/sce President of Finance/vice President of Fellowship Honors in Action Coordinator College Projectordinator.

Section1: The duties of the Presidentshall be as follows:

- b. Createanddistribute allmeetingagendas 2 hoursin advance.
- c. Vote only in the case of a tie
- d. Overseeall officer responsibilities.
- e. Appoint an officer to fill any vacancies sneeded.
- f. Createandestablishan officer position as needed with a majority vote.
- g. Co-facilitate the Honorsin Action projectalong with the ExecutiveVice President
- h. Hostthe Fall and SpringInductionCeremony(or delegate)

Section2: The duties of the ExecutiveVice Presidentshall be as follows:

- a. Performall duties of the President n the event of his/herabsence.
- b. Assistasneededn thedutiesof the President.
- c. Co-facilitate the Honorsin Action projectalong with the President.
- d. Assistin the duties of officer positions not yetfilled.

Section3: The duties of the Vice President of Serviceshall be as follows:

- a. Co-facilitate the college project along with the Vice President of Scholarship
- b. Researchandpresentserviceprojectsworthy of chapterparticipationthroughout the year
- c. Facilitatea minimum of two (2) service projects for each Fall and Springsemester.

Section4: The duties of the Vice President of Scholarshipshall be as follows:

- a. Co-facilitate the college project along with the Vice President of Service
- b. Researchandpresentscholarlyactivitiesworthy of chapterparticipation throughout the year
- c. Facilitatea minimum of two (2) scholarshipactivities for eachFall andSpring semester.

Section5: The duties of the Vice President of Public Relationsshall be as follows:

- a. Takepicturesat chapterevents and activities held throughout the academic year.
- b. Updatepictureslideshowfor the Fall and SpringInductionCeremony
- c. Maintain chapterwebsite and social media.

d. Create presæleases of upcoming and past chapter events and activities for distribution all chaptermembersthePublicInformationOffice (PIO), the Chariot, etc.

Section6: The duties of the Vice President of Recordshall be as follows:

- a. Takeattendance atll meetings.
- b. Maintain a record of all meetings.
- c. Maintain a record of all chapter events and activities held throughout the academicyear.

Section7: The duties of the Vice President of Finance shall be as follows:

- a. Work with the advisor to stay updated on account balances uadgets.
- b. Work with the advisor to prepare and present fundingroval requests.
- c. Organize and coordinate fundraising efforts when necessary.

Section8: The duties of the Vice President of Fellowship shall be as follows:

- a. At least once a semester, work with the advisor and officers to schedule executive officer events.
- b. At least once a semester, work with the advisor and officers to schedule fellowship events for members.
- c. Coordinate events whitother campus organizations, specifically the Honors Scholar Program.

Section9: The duties of the Honors in Action Coordinator shall be as follows:

- a. Organize teamto conductundergraduate search.
- b. Organizeactivities to support the research (project).
- c. Measureprogressquantitativelyandqualitatively.
- d. Presenbi-monthly updates at eachbusines meeting

Section 10: The duties of the CollegeProject Coordinator shall be as follows:

- a. Work with CollegeAdministrator.
- b. Organizea teamto assesshe goal setby the administrator.
- c. Organizea teamto carryout the project for MiraCostaCollege.
- d. Measureprogressquantitativelyandqualitatively
- e. Presenbi-monthly updates at eachbusines meeting.
